Seminar-cum-Workshop on Hegemony

A two day national-level workshop on 'Hegemony' will be held for researchers and practitioners of action research on February 12 and 14, 2019 (10 am to 5.30 pm) in the Economics Department, University of Calcutta under its DSA-I program. The last date of registration is 8/02/2019 and. An application for participation with a brief self-introduction (not more than fifty words) and present affiliation may be sent to aceco@caluniv.ac.in. The maximum number of seat is 30 and selection of candidates will be based on the criteria given below. Expenses for accommodation and travel have to borne by the participants. Prof Anup Dhar, Ambedkar University, New Delhi and Prof Anjan Chakrabarty, University of Calcutta would be among the resource persons.

Selection Criteria: Since the workshop will focus on an advanced engagement with the question of 'hegemony', the minimum criteria required for attending would be a 'fairly comprehensive understanding of critical Marxian Theory (including a thorough reading of Marx's *Capital*, Resnick and Wolff and Gibson-Graham), Political Philosophy and Psychoanalysis (including writings of Althusser, Lacan and Laclau-Mouffe). It is expected that applicants know the first area well and fairly thoroughly the second area.
